Mission Statement: Dynamic Footworks is a school that appreciates the art of dance at all levels and skills. We do our very best to enhance the talent of, and enjoy working with each student. We will provide professional dance instruction and instill the art of dance in a safe environment. Dynamic Footworks is a family atmosphere home to supportive parents & talented students and where lasting friendships are made. The gift of dance is an investment in your child's self confidence. We are dedicated to helping students succeed.

The Curriculum: Offering a variety of recreational and competitive dance training. The styles that are offered are: Tap, Jazz, Ballet, Clogging, Hip-Hop, Lyrical/Contemporary, Pointe, and Tumbling/Acrobatics. Classes are offered from Ages two through Adult. Students will be placed according to age and ability. The dance season runs from September-May.

Monthly Newsletters: Monthly news will be available to all students on the studio website beginning the month of September. Newsletters will also be emailed to addresses that are provided when registering online. All newsletters will be sent out the first week of each month. There will also be a paper copy posted in studio observation areas. Please take time to read all newsletters. This will help to eliminate confusion or missed due dates.

Class Size: If a class size drops below four students the class may be combined with another class or cancelled. If a class size becomes too large then class may be split in order to provide the best possible quality for each student.

Performances: Selected classes will be asked to perform in various community performances such as local Leland performances, Azalea Festival, and charity events. Classes selected will be based on the upcoming event, the amount of choreography known, and the classes ability to participate.

Payments and Fees: Registration fee is a non-refundable fee of \$25.00.

Tuition: Tuition is based on a yearly rate and then offered to you in a monthly payment plan. Tuition is due on the first of the month and considered late after the 15th. **A \$20.00 late fee will be added to all payments that arrive after the 10th.** There is no prorated months for missed lessons,

holiday closings, closings due to weather or class attendance. If tuition goes two months past due from the 1st you will NOT be allowed to return to dance until payment is made current.

30 minute Classes: \$40.00 per month,

45 minute classes: \$45.00 per month, 1 hour classes: \$50.00 per month.

1 hour 15 minute classes:\$75.00

You may enroll at dynamicdance.biz. A password will be emailed to you within minutes. At that time you will be able to access your account and change your password. You will then have a parent portal created to see your account and all studio news. Please sign up for auto draft for monthly tuition to be taking out. You will be able to choose a date or dates for the drafts to be withdrawn during that month.

Cash and checks will be accepted until the 15th of every month. Only online payments will be accepted after the 15th.

There will be a \$25.00 return check fee for any returned checks.

It is highly recommended to sign up for auto draft for your monthly payments to be drafted. Upon enrollment all dance accounts must have a current and valid credit card on account.

DFS will issue a \$15.00 late fee and the credit card on file will be processed for balance owed.

DFS will process cards for monthly tuition with information on file for all past due dance accounts not paid in full prior to the 15th of each month.

If you already have a credit card on file..Thank You!! If you dont or the credit card needs to be updated please log onto your portal and update credit card information.

Spring Recital Costume Payment Installments: Recreational classes are \$75.00 and competitive classes are \$85.00.

Competitive Classes-1/2 will be due by **Friday October 14th**. The remaining balance will be due **No Later than November 11th**.

Recreational Classes-1/2 will be due by **Friday October 14th**. The remaining balance must be paid in full **no later than December 8th**. There will be a \$10.00 late fee for late payments.

All costume fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**. Shoes, alterations, tights and any additional hair pieces , etc. are not included in costume fees. All tuition fees must be current before any money will be applied to costume fees. Students will not receive their costume(s) or recital tickets until the balance has been paid in full.

Costume and Recital Fee Payments may NOT be made online. Cash, Checks or money orders will be accepted only for costumes and recital fees. If a student withdraws from a class after purchasing a costume, the student or family will be contacted when the costume is available for pick-up.

All costumes will be handed out by the end of April.

Recitals: We will be having a Christmas Recital and an Annual Spring Recital. All students are expected to participate in both recitals.

There will be a recital fee for both of these. Due dates, fees and dates for both recitals will be posted by the end of September. All updates will be posted on our website www.dynamicdance.biz.

Dress Code: Hair must be pulled back away from the face . If hair falls at shoulders or below, hair must be pulled back in a ponytail at all times. Proper dance attire and shoes are required for all students in all classes.

Please limit jewelry to single studded earrings.

When students dress like dancers, they feel like dancers, and perform like dancers!

The entire class stays more focused when properly dressed for class. Dress Code is listed below for each style of dance.

Clogging-recreation & competitive

According to when you order them it may take weeks to receive them. Loose clothing is to be worn. NO DENIM!

Hip-Hop-recreational & competitive

Any loose clothing can be worn. Pants need to pass the knee and any top. NO DENIM.

Any street style **CLEAN** bottomed sneaker may be worn until performance shoes are decided on.

Lyrical/Contemporary/Technique-recreational & competitive

Nude Foot Undez- Pink, Lavender or Black Leotards /Tan tights/Hair worn in Buns

Tumbling/Acrobatics

Barefoot, and Unitard

No tights

Males- wear loose fitting clothing-NO Denim

DFS has all attire and shoes with exception of clogging shoes for sale for your convenience. There will be designated days and times to order shoes and attire. All attire and shoes ordered on these dates will be by starting dates for classes.**Please make sure that all shoes,coats, etc. are labeled with their names.** DFS is **NOT** responsible for lost or stolen items.

There is a bulletin board in the waiting room. You may place your name and phone number on the board of items that you wish to sell.

Attendance:

Attendance is very important. Absences from class affect everyone's progress in class. Please contact us if the dancer will be absent so the teacher can plan accordingly. To receive perfect attendance students must be enrolled prior to January 1. Attendance will be taken in each class and students with perfect attendance will be recognized at the Spring Recital. Competitive members cannot miss more than five unexcused absences in the season, or 2 consecutive. If amount is exceeded a doctors note must be presented to teacher the week that student returns.

Classroom /Lobby/and Studio Protocol:

Parent observation week is the first lesson of each month.

No food or drinks in waiting room or dance rooms.

Students are encouraged to bring water bottles to class if they are attending more than one class back to back.

No chewing gum in studio.

Please do not allow children to run around, or play rough in the studio.

Siblings and friends of students should not be let unattended in the dance studio at any time. An adult must supervise siblings or friends that are not participating in class. Parents supervision is required prior to and immediately following class.

Inappropriate language or conversations within the studio is not permitted. All students are to use the restroom before class. Please make every effort to arrive on time for classes. The first of every class is very important in order to begin the class.

Friends may be allowed in the dance room ONLY if they are participating and trying a trial class. We cannot be responsible for unsupervised children.

There are to be no acrobatic tricks performed in the lobby area.

Good attitude, good attendance and practice at home are expected from each student.

Student/Parent/Teacher:

The instructors are very busy teaching classes and their schedules run very tight. Please drop a note in the payment box so that your questions and concerns may get proper attention . If you have concerns or questions you will be contacted as quickly as possible.

Opening Classroom Doors: Please wait patiently for students class time to end and respect our instructors. **DO NOT** open classroom doors during class time. If a student needs to leave

class early , let the teacher know as classes are changing or notify Amber via email or a phone call.

Students that may occur disruptive behavior repeatedly may be dismissed from class. Tuition for the month attending during dismissal will not be refunded!

Please help us maintain a presentable atmosphere for all studio families and staff members.

Holidays, Closings, and Cancellations:

Our dance season runs from September through May.

We will close for a Christmas, and a Spring break. The studio will generally follow the holiday schedule observed by the traditional school calendar. We do not cancel classes if school has a teacher work day.

If a class is cancelled for unexpected reasons such as illness, we will provide a make-up class for the students that had the cancelled class(es). If classes are canceled due to weather conditions or concerns, power failures or natural acts, the class(es) will NOT be made up.
